Management Committee

 Army Public School, LBS Marg is managed and governed by Headquarter Central Command, Lucknow. The CSO Headquarter Central Command, Lucknow is the Patron, Brig AAD HQ CC is the Chairman of the School Administration & Management Committee which comprises of experienced officers, teachers and eminent educationists.

Rules and Regulations

Admission

- The School has been established to cater to the educational requirements of the wards of Army personnel. Consequently, children of serving Army personnel coming on transfer from out station will not be denied admission at any time of the year subject to availability of seat and qualifying in the Entrance Examination.
- The School admits boys and girls of above 5 years of age.
- Admission to any class except class-I is made after a pre-admission test. A valid transfer certificate from the previous institution is a mandatory requirement for admission.
- A student coming from another recognized school shall not be admitted to a class higher than the one in which he/she was studying at his/her former school, unless promoted to the next higher class at the end of the academic session.
- No provisional admission is permitted under any circumstances.

Priorities of Admission

- Children of serving Army personnels (including DSC), children of Army widows and TA personnel who have a minimum of 10 years embodied service.
- Children of Ex-servicemen, DSC personnel retired with pension from DSC.
- Children of serving Air Force and Naval personnel.
- Children of civilians paid out of Defence Estimates, Para Military Forces including Coast Guards, MES, GREF and TA (when not embodied).
- Other children.



Registration for Admission

- 1. Registration for fresh admission opens normally in the first week of January.
- For fresh admission, registration forms duly filled must be submitted in the office before the closing date and a receipt obtained for the same.
- The schedule for the Entrance Exams will be available on the School Notice Board/School Website (www.apslbslko.ac.in)

Proof of Age

- In case of Defence Personnel, extract of their record of service, (Part II order) duly attested by their Commanding Officer will be accepted as a conclusive proof for age of their children.
- Birth certificate issued by Military/Civilian Hospitals as well as Municipalities/Village Panchayats will also be accepted.

Change of Date of Birth

 Once recorded in the School register, change in the date of birth will not normally be accepted, except where overwhelming documentary evidence exists and where a genuine mistake has been committed.



Educational System

- Class (I IX) will follow Remodelled Assessment Structure by CBSE for evaluation similar to Class X.

Attendance, Absence, Fine and Re-admission Fees

As regular attendance is an important requirement for successful result, a written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the guardian should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible.

- A minimum attendance of 75% of the total working days is required during the academic year, falling short of which the student will not be able to take the examination that year.
- During School hours no student can leave the School personally without the written permission of the Principal which may be granted in exceptional circumstances based on a written request of parents.

Card System for Discipline

To maintain discipline in the school and to deal with indiscipline cases, a discipline committee is constituted, headed by the Vice-Principal and assisted by two senior teachers. A system of issuing Green, Yellow, Red and Black cards has been introduced to deal with indiscipline cases. Details are given in the school diary. Parents are requested to read it.

Parental Cooperation

- Parents are requested to look into their child's School Diary every day and see that the lessons and the homework assigned for the next day are done regularly.
- If the child is not making the desired progress, please make it a point to discuss it with the Principal and the Class Teacher.
- Parents are requested to inform the School for any change of address & contact number.
- Parents are required to send their children to School on time. Presence of every child
 in the assembly is compulsory.
- A sick child must not be sent to the School with medicines to be taken during the school hours.
- Please encourage your child to participate in all activities of the School.
- Parents are requested to send their child in proper School uniform.



Parent-Teacher Meeting

 The School periodically organises parent-teacher meetings, where interactive sessions are arranged to focus on the child's education, welfare and overall performance. Attendance of the parents at such meetings is compulsory.

Library Rules & Regulations

- Books will be issued and returned as per rules framed by the School.
- Books will be issued for a definite period of time.
- Only one book may be issued at a time.
- 4 Tearing, writing, scribbling or folding pages of books will be considered damage done to book.
- 5 Students losing books or damaging them will be asked to pay the cost of the book.
- 6 All library books issued to the students must be returned before the commencement of the annual examination.







detention in the same class would make the student too old for his/her class.


- (d) That no fees, partial or full will be refunded if the said student is required to leave the School during term time for any reason other than medical grounds acceptable to the Principal.
